

JAPAN HOTELS

TOKYO



▲ Shiba Park Hotel

The three-star Shiba Park Hotel is located in the centre of Tokyo, within walking distance to restaurants and major sightseeing attractions such as the Tokyo Tower. The guest rooms are comfortable and well-appointed, and the hotel facilities include a Michelin star restaurant, gift shop and business centre.

KANAZAWA



▲ Hotel Kanazawa

The Hotel Kanazawa is located only 1 minute from the JR Kanazawa Train Station. It offers modern accommodations with 3 dining options and free internet in rooms. With spacious interiors, guest rooms offer air-conditioning and heating, as well as fridge, electric kettle and a TV with cable.

TAKAYAMA



▲ Takayama Ryu Resort & Spa

Nestled among the mountains of Takayama, this resort sits at an altitude of around 1,000 metres. Surrounded by nature, guests can enjoy views from the rooftop terrace, relax in the hot springs or swim in the outdoor pool. Rooms feature tatami (woven-straw) flooring and Japanese futon bedding. The restaurant offers a diverse menu of Japanese cuisine.

KYOTO



▲ Karasuma Hotel Kyoto

Hotel Karasuma Kyoto is located in the traditional Shimogyo Ward at the intersection of Shijo and Karasuma streets. The location is prime for sightseeing, with easy access to rail transport. The hotel features a restaurant, lobby bar and currency exchange. The guest rooms include free wifi and modern amenities.

KOYASAN



▲ Hojo-in

The Hojo-in is an original shukubo (temple-stay) tucked away in a small side street of Koyasan. A peaceful atmosphere emanates throughout and you have the chance to step into a completely different world. The traditional wooden buildings are beautifully maintained, with some recent additions to the complex. The rooms have a traditional Japanese feel, with immaculate tatami flooring, striking sliding doors, antique decorations and ornate gardens. The food, shojin ryori is traditional vegetarian Buddhist cuisine. Don't miss the early morning prayer with the resident monks – it is an experience you won't ever forget.

OSAKA



▲ Hotel Monterey Osaka

Located a five-minute walk from JR Osaka Train Station, Hotel Monterey Osaka is well-located for travellers. Guest rooms are designed to look like rooms in Vienna's Schönbrunn Palace, and have free wifi. The hotel overall emanates an atmosphere reminiscent of the Austrian royal court.

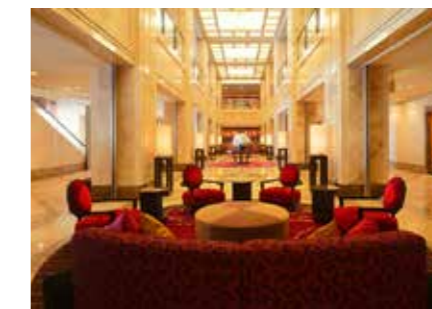
HAKONE



▲ Hakone Fujiya Hotel

Located in the hot spring resort of Hakone, this is a traditional resort style hotel. The resort is only a short walk from Hakone Yumoto Train Station, with Lake Ashinoko 17km away. The hotel offers 4 dining options, including Japanese, Chinese and International. Rooms have a sitting area, bathtub & air conditioning.

NARA



▲ Hotel Nikko Nara

Connected to JR Nara Station, the Hotel Nikko Nara is located a ten-minute drive from Nara Park and 45-minutes by train from Kyoto. The property has five dining options, karaoke facilities and the guest rooms with free wifi, a bath tub and modern amenities.

NAGANO



▲ Hotel Kokusai 21 Nagano

Hotel Kokusai 21 is a five-minute drive from JR Nagano Station. It features eight dining options, including a sky lounge with panoramic city views. It offers a Japanese stone spa and a beauty salon. Guest rooms are contemporary with modern amenities and free wifi.

HIROSHIMA



▲ Hotel Granvia Hiroshima
