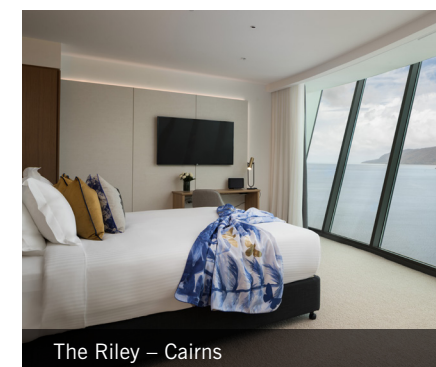

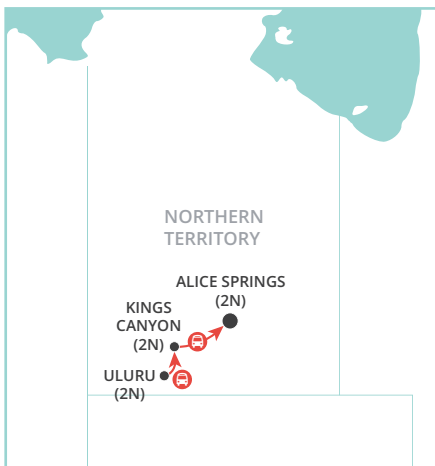

Everything here is magnified, striking rock formations billions of years old, tropical islands shaded by sky high treetops and thundering waterfalls that shower you with magic.

Commencing in Broome, the gateway to the Kimberley, you will witness the natural phenomenon 'staircase to the moon' where a full moon rises over the tidal flats of Roebuck Bay, illuminating a staircase of light to the moons' edge.
