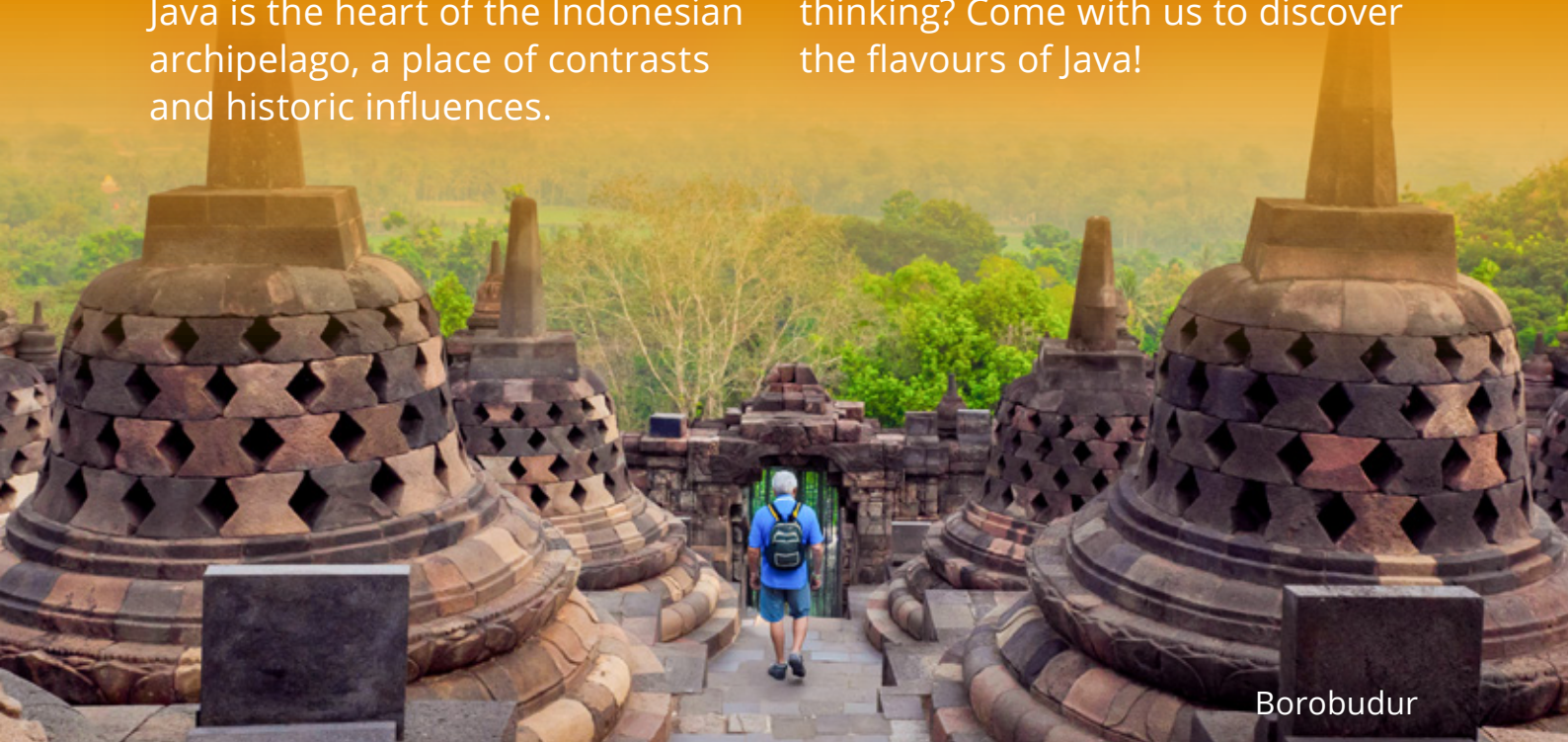

TASTE OF INDONESIA: BEEF RENDANG



Ingredients:

800g beef chuck, cubed
400ml coconut milk
2 tbsp rendang paste
2 kaffir lime leaves
1 lemongrass stalk, bruised
2 tbsp tamarind paste
2 tbsp palm sugar
Salt to taste

Method:

1. Heat coconut milk in a large pot, add rendang paste and stir until fragrant
2. Add beef, lime leaves and lemongrass. Bring to a simmer
3. Cook on low heat for 2-3 hours, stirring occasionally until beef is tender
4. Add tamarind paste and palm sugar in final 30 minutes
5. Continue cooking until sauce thickens and darkens
6. Serve with steamed rice

Crawl through the Cu Chi Tunnels

The Cu Chi Tunnels, located just outside of Saigon, offer an interesting look at Vietnam's recent history. During the war with the USA, Viet Cong soldiers lived and fought underground to escape shellings and chemical attacks. You can actually crawl through a section of tunnel like those used by the Viet Cong—an insightful look into wartime survival.



Taste the perfect pho in Hanoi

Vietnam's most famous dish, pho is a delicious broth full of noodles, herbs and sometimes meat. It originated in Hanoi and the city has made the dish its own. From restaurants to street stalls, every place has its own secret recipe. While it's actually a breakfast food, pho can be eaten any time of day—and there's no better place to try it than Hanoi.



Haggle with H'Mong in Sapa

Every Sunday, Sapa sees people from surrounding hill tribe communities travel into town to sell their crafts. Dressed in colourful, traditional clothing, these traders—mostly women—create a lively atmosphere as the market becomes as much a social gathering as a place for business. The H'Mong and Red Dao are two of the main tribes in the area, and their embroidery work draws you to stalls of vivid textiles as you wander the market.

WHAT TO WEAR, WHEN

WINTER (Dec - Feb)

Northern region: Cool to cold – warm jacket, jumpers, gloves, scarf

Central: Warm days, cool evenings – light layers

Southern region: Warm and dry – lightweight cotton

SPRING/AUTUMN (Mar - May & Sep - Nov)

Mild weather nationwide – light layers, evening jacket

Note for Nov: Central storms possible. Bring jacket for mountains.

SUMMER/WET SEASON (Jun - Aug)

Warm and humid with afternoon rains – quick-dry fabrics, waterproof jacket

Bukchon Hanok Village

It's 11pm on a weeknight and I'm strolling unknown streets. A quick search on Naver reveals Seoul's famous Gwangjang Market is within walking distance. Ten minutes later, I'm inhaling the incredible cooking aromas and staring at the bustle within.

Mandu (dumplings) stuffed with kimchi or prawns. Tteokbokki. Mung bean pancakes. Bowls of bibimbap. Knife-cut noodles made famous in Street Food: Asia. For dessert, hotteok. Down some aisles, stallholders sell delicacies like freeze-dried strawberries, ginseng candy, dried fish and jeotgal. After a few laps and trying some treats, I'm full and only about AU\$18 poorer.

It's just after 10pm. Stalls are closing, but K-beauty stores, bars, jjimjilbang and noraebang are still open. Seoul offers stiff competition to New York as the city that never sleeps. More importantly, it feels perfectly safe. For a solo traveller, it feels like a luxury money can't buy.

In less than three hours on the KTX trains from Seoul, you can be in Busan. The coastline is ragged here, connected by incredible bridges. It's the perfect blend of relaxed seaside holiday spots and lively cultural attractions. Before you leave, experience a favourite Korean pastime: Spa Land in Centum City, a huge luxury facility where you can bathe in mineral pools, get scrubbed, enjoy the hammam, relax in a massage chair and more. You'll be naked in the single-gender baths, but comfy shorts and t-shirts are supplied for saunas and co-ed spaces. As they say, when in South Korea...
