## Day 1: Journey to Imlil

Meals: D

Start in Casablanca, where you will transfer to Casa Voyageurs train station to board a local train to Marrakech, a journey of approximately 3 hours. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to a local restaurant where lunch can be enjoyed at your own expense.



Go on to journey to Imlil, a journey of approximately 1 and a half hours, to a small village, home to a Berber community, nestled within the High Atlas Mountains, and admire the breathtaking vistas of untamed peaks that surround you. Discover the marketplaces selling hand-made items, spices and fresh food, all before meeting a local muleteer, who will escort you to your guest house.

#### **Destination Information**

Imlil — Gateway to the Atlas Mountains. Just 90 minutes from Marrakech, Imlil is a peaceful Berber village nestled in the High Atlas Mountains. Surrounded by terraced fields and rugged peaks, it's the main starting point for treks to Mount Toubkal, North Africa's highest summit. With its cool mountain air, traditional guesthouses, and stunning scenery, Imlil offers a perfect mix of adventure and authenticity. Whether hiking, exploring nearby villages, or simply relaxing, it's an ideal escape into Morocco's natural beauty and mountain culture.

### Day 2: Learn about Berber culture

Embark on a 3-hour hiking tour of Imlil with a local mountain guide and witness the day-to day life of the local Berber people as you trek through the picturesque valleys and encounter terraced fields and charming villages. Learn about Berber culture and the many traditions unique to the tribes, before going on to enjoy lunch as a local Berber house. Afterwards, indulge in a traditional Moroccan tea ceremony and enjoy the rest of your day at leisure.
