Day 1: Arrive Uluwatu

Meals: D

Arrive in Bali and transfer to your hotel. Visit Uluwatu's cliffside temple and see a Kecak dance performance before enjoying a seafood dinner at Jimbaran Beach.



Destination Information

Bali — is a province of Indonesia located between Java and Lombok. It is often referred to as the "Island of the Gods," . This tropical paradise offers a blend of ancient tradition and modern comfort and is Indonesia's most famous tourist destination, known for its rich culture, stunning landscapes, and warm hospitality.

Day 2: Eastern Bali

Meals: B, D

Embark on a full-day jeep tour of Eastern Bali. Enjoy the unique beauty of Bali's natural wonders, including Sidemen village and Tirta Gangga.



Destination Information

Sidemen village — is located in eastern Bali in the foothills of Mount Agung. It is known for it's tranquil atmosphere, lush green landscapes and stunning rice terraces.

Tirta Gangga — also known as the water palace, is a former royal residence named after the sacred Ganges River in India, meaning "Water of the Ganges." Spanning 2.5 acres, the palace grounds feature a series of ponds, pools, tiered fountains, and stone sculptures of mythical figures set amidst lush gardens.



Day 3: Ubud Meals: B

Start your day at Tirta Empul, a sacred water temple, then explore the cliff-carved shrines of Gunung Kawi. In the afternoon, discover Ubud, Bali's cultural heart, before returning to your hotel.



Destination Information

Tirta Empul Temple — is a Balinese water temple located in near the town of Tampaksiring. Tirta Empul translates as 'holy water springs' and is where visitors can participate in a traditional purification ritual, a spiritual journey to cleanse their body, mind, and soul.

Guning Kawi Temple – is one of Bali's oldest and largest ancient monuments dating back to the 11th century. Also known as 'The Valley of The Balinese Kings'. It is located in a lush valley and features ten shrines (candis), some of which reach 7 meters high, carved into the rock face.

Ubud – is known as the cultural heart of Bali. The centre of traditional crafts, dance, music, architecture and surrounded by Hindu water temples, shrines, waterfalls and rice terraces.

Day 4: Departure Meals: B
