## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Arrive Bangkok**

Meals: None

Upon arrival at Bangkok's Suvarnabhumi International airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Depending on your time of arrival, the rest of the day is at leisure.

**Destination Information**

**Bangkok** - Bangkok has been Thailand's dominant city since the 18th century. It was established as the capital after the former capital, Ayutthaya, was razed to the ground by the Burmese army. It was the centre point of the modernisation of Siam in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century, leading the introduction of rail transport, the printing press, healthcare and utilities infrastructure. With a population of over 10 million, the fast pace of the city can be intense; however, beneath the hustle and bustle, there are many hidden gems waiting to be discovered.

**Day 2: Bangkok City & Hua Hin**

Meals: B

Embark on a half-day tour of Bangkok's most iconic sights. Visit Wat Traimit and the Grand Palace, including the sacred Temple of the Emerald Buddha. After the city tour, drive approximately 3 hours south to the coastal city of Hua Hin.

**Destination Information**

**Wat Traimit** – Wat Traimit is a historic Buddhist temple located in Yaowarat, Bangkok's Chinatown and houses the world's largest Golden Buddha statues.

**Grand Palace** - The Grand Palace is the city's most famous landmark. From 1782 until 1925, it was the official residence of the Kings of Siam; it is still used for many royal ceremonies and state events. It Palace are several impressive buildings, including the Temple of the Emerald Buddha.

**Hua Hin** - Hua Hin is a beloved seaside escape for Bangkok residents, known for its relaxed atmosphere and family-friendly charm. Unlike some nearby resorts, it offers a peaceful setting where you can enjoy the beach, local markets, and coastal beauty without the bustle of all-night partying

**Days 3-5: Free Time in Hua Hin**

Meals: B

Spend three days all out relaxing on the beach or at your resort, perhaps with a visit or two to some local markets. There are plenty of places to taste the varied and delicious flavours of Thai street food, which is a must do!
