## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Arrive Chongqing**

Meals: None

Make your way to Chongqing airport or railway station. Upon arrival, you will be met by your local guide and transferred to your hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure.

**Destination Information**

**Chongqing** - A city perched on the steep hills overlooking the confluence of the Jialing and the Yangtze Rivers, Chongqing is the chief industrial centre of south west China, producing approximately one fifth of Sichuan's industrial output. Chongqing has been reshaped by the Three Gorges Dam Project, which now allows larger sea-going vessels to sail all the way upriver to China's most famous waterfront mountain city.

**Day 2: Discover Chongqing**

Meals: B, L, D

The day begins with a visit to Lizhiba, where you can view the unique sight of light rail trains passing through buildings. Next is a stroll through Eling Park and the creative Eling Factory Cultural Park, followed by a drive through Chongqing's dizzying overpasses. After a traditional hot pot lunch, the afternoon includes visits to the Liberation Tower and Kuixing Buildings. A trip to the Cloud Eye Observatory offers stunning panoramic views from 520 meters above. In the evening, visit Hongya Cave, where you can enjoy local street food and a vibrant riverside atmosphere.

**Destination Information**

**Eling Park** - E'ling Park in Chongqing is a historic hilltop garden offering panoramic views of the Yangtze and Jialing Rivers. Built in 1909, it features traditional pavilions, flower gardens, and the Liangjiang Pavilion for stunning city vistas. It's a peaceful escape ideal for sightseeing and photography.

**Hongya Cave** - a striking cliffside complex of stilted buildings that combines traditional Bayu architecture with modern shops, restaurants, and bars. Lit up beautifully at night, it offers stunning river views and a vibrant atmosphere, making it a must-visit for food, photos, and local culture.

**Day 3: Depart Chongqing**
