Please note: In Dubai, hotels charge 'Tourism Dirham Fee' per room per night of occupancy (for a maximum of 30 consecutive nights) ranging from AED 10 to AED 20 depending on the category/grade of the hotel. Upon check out from the Hotel, the Tourism Fee will be collected by hotels on behalf of the government. Hotels are unable to collect the Fee in advance or invoice tour operators. Instead, guests will be informed of the fee upon check-in, with the fee collected by the hotels as mandated by law.
