ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive Harbin Meals: None

Make your way to Harbin airport or railway station. Upon arrival, you will be met by your local guide and transferred to your hotel.

The rest of the day is at leisure to relax and prepare for the magical Harbin Ice and Snow Festival.

Destination Information

Harbin Ice and Snow Festival - Running from December to February, it is the world's largest ice and snow festival.

Day 2: Ice and Snow World Meals: B, L

Head to the popular Ice and Snow World and wander among the illuminated full-size buildings built entirely of ice and witness astounding snow and ice sculptures.

Later, tour the city centre, filled with grand European-style buildings, including Central Avenue and Sophia Cathedral.



Day 3: Snow Lantern Festival Meals: B, L

Start your day with a visit to the Shong Hua River, where you can observe ice water swimming, ice windsurfing and other winter activities.

Then, head across to Sun Island, to see the enormous snow sculptures set in its landscaped grounds.

Later, mingle with people from all over the world at the Ice Lantern Festival, to admire more spectacular ice carvings brought to life through beautiful illuminations.

Day 4: Depart Harbin Meals: B

Your day is at leisure until the time comes to transfer to the airport or railway station for your onward journey.
