Extension | 4 Days | Physical Level 1 Delhi – Shimla (2N) – Delhi (1N)

#### **ITINERARY**

## Day 1: Train to Shimla

Meals: None

Rise early to meet your guide at your Delhi hotel to transfer to New Delhi train station and board the Shatabadi Express train to Chandigarh. Your transfer coordinator will accompany you to the train station and assist to board the train, but on the train, you will be travelling unaccompanied. On arrival you will be met at the station and transferred to Shimla, followed by a check in to your hotel for 2 nights.



Please note Shimla is at high altitude 2,196m.

#### **Destination Information**

**Shimla** - The picturesque capital of Himachal Pradesh was once the summer capital of British India. Spread 12kms along a ridge that overlooks terraced hillsides and cultivations, Shimla is magnificently covered in dense forests of oak, pine, fur and rhododendron. In Shimla the altitude is 2,196m.

### Day 2: Explore Shimla

Meals: B, L

Meet your local guide this morning and start the day with a walk to Jakhoo Temple, which sits at the highest point of the city, offering incredible views.

Later, transfer to Shimla Railway station to board the Toy train to Kandaghat, admiring the scenic views during your journey. Your guide will accompany you on this train ride. After lunch sightseeing around Shimla will start with a visit to one of Shimla's major landmarks the Christ Church, the



second oldest church in Northern India, and then visit Scandal Point. In the afternoon visit the Himalayan Aviary, home to many species, including the Himalayan Monal.

#### **Destination Information**

**Jakhoo Temple** - An ancient temple in Shimla that is dedicated to Hindu deity, Hanuman. It is located on Jakhoo Hill at a height of 2,455 m above sea level.



### Day 3: Shimla to Delhi

Meals: B, D

This morning, admire the renaissance grandeur of the Vice Regal Lodge located on Observatory Hill, before driving back to Kalka. Take the Shatabadi Express train to Delhi enjoying dinner on board. Please note the train journey is unaccompanied, but you will be met by a driver at the Delhi station, who will transfer you to your hotel.



#### **Destination Information**

**Delhi** - As the capital of India, Delhi is the third largest city with a population of approximately 18 million. Its strategic location along the north-south, east-west route has given it a focal position in Indian history and many great empires have been ruled from here. The monuments and ruins of these are scattered throughout the city, often side by side with modern structures and high-rise towers.

# Day 4: Depart Delhi

Meals: B

After check-out you will be transferred to Delhi airport for your onward flight.
