Yufuin

ITINERARY

Day 1: Travel to Yufuin

Meals: D

Depart Hakata, Fukuoka, on the Yufuin no Mori Limited Express Train 3 to Yufuin.

Leave your luggage at your ryokan and enjoy free at leisure. Ryokan check in at 3pm.

Dinner tonight is at your ryokan.



Please note: Train tickets are purchased 30 days prior to the ride date. Timing will be advised on reservation.

Ryokan - All guest rooms are Japanese style, room with bath. Meals are seasonal KAISEKI dishes (kaiseki is Japanese typical meal.) Free to use public and family outdoor hot spring for the guests.

Destination Information

Yufuin no Mori - Is one of Kyushu's most popular scenic limited express trains, operating between Hakata (Fukuoka) and Yufuin. Recognisable by its distinctive retro green exterior and elegant wood-panelled interior. The journey to Yufuin takes approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes, featuring picturesque countryside views, onboard refreshments, and fully reserved seating for added comfort and convenience.

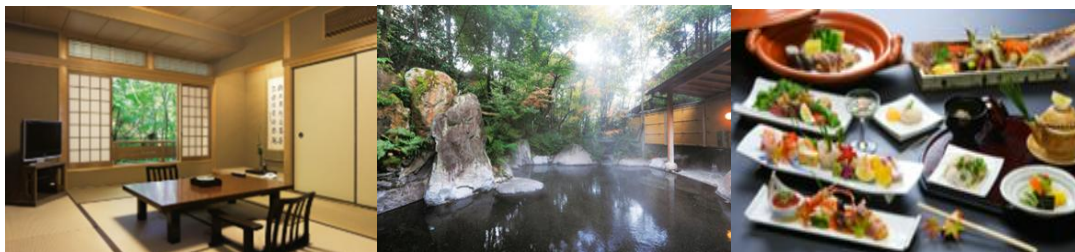
